* All U of M-Dearborn students, both freshman and transfers, are required to take an English Composition placement test. Students who have taken Eng 121 and 225 but place below Comp 105 will need to take Comp 227 at U of M-Dearborn.

** Minimum two courses needed in Humanities and two courses in Beh Sci/Soc Science. Then take a fifth course, which must be 300-level or higher, in one **same subject** used in **either** the Humanities **or** the Behavioral Science/Social Science area.

*** U of M-Dearborn's Chem 146 & Engr 126 are not required in Electrical Engineering or Computer Engineering.

NOTES:

- Seven undergraduate programs offered: BS in Computer and Information Science or Software Engineering, and BSE in Electrical Engineering, Industrial and Systems Engineering, Manufacturing Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, or Computer Engineering, all with option of co-op program. Dual Degrees are available in EE/CE or in ISE/MFGE. Manufacturing Engr and Industrial and Systems Engr are the only two undergraduate degree programs offered in the evening.
- GPA of 2.75** (overall GPA, separate math GPA, and separate science GPA) are required for admission into the College of Engineering and Computer Science (CECS). Courses with C- grade or below do not transfer.
- Transfer is possible before completion of all courses listed, for Fall (Sept), Winter (Jan), or Summer (May) admission.
- Since requirements may change, it's a student's responsibility to check with UM-Dearborn Admissions for latest information.
