- * You are 24 years of age or younger and either parent lives outside the state of Michigan.
- * You are 24 years of age or younger and have attended or graduated from a high school outside the state of Michigan.
- * You have attended or graduated from an out-of-state high school and have been involved in educational pursuits for the majority of time since high school graduation.
- * You previously attended any U-M campus (Ann Arbor, Dearborn, or Flint) as a nonresident.

Other circumstances may also require you to file a residency application.

Residency Applications can be obtained from the Residency Classification Office, 1210 LSA Building, 500 South State Street, Ann Arbor, MI 48109-1382, phone (734) 764-1400. The deadline dates for submitting an Application for Resident Classification apply to the term for which residency is sought and are as follows: September 30 for Fall Term, January 31 for Winter Term, July 31 for Spring, Spring/Summer, and Summer Terms. Applications must be received in the Residency Classification Office by 5 p.m. EST on the deadline date. Applicants who do not file by the deadline will be responsible for paying nonresident tuition. Exceptions will not be granted.
