Please Read Carefully: You may be eligible for a non-resident graduate tuition scholarship if

1. You are a non-resident graduate student in engineering or computer science program.
2. You elect at least 6 cr. hrs/semester and have a min. GPA = 6.0 (B+ equivalent) if you are a continuing student.
3. You are not employed off-campus and show need for tuition scholarship (**attach documentation such as bank loan approval or documents that prove you are paying tuition on your own. Students on training visas are ineligible.**)
4. You are not working as a GSI or GSRA. If you are employed as a GSI/GSRA during the semester you must immediately inform the Associate Dean about your employment.
5. If you are renewing your scholarship, please also submit a copy of your latest transcript and class schedule for the upcoming semester.
